



LOOKING FOR MPS TO STRUGGLE AGAINST DEEP POVERTY! Calling All Parliamentary Candidates to Combat Deep Poverty

Deep Poverty Network has launched a campaign calling on all parliamentary candidates to combat poverty and prioritize this struggle with a rights-based perspective. The campaign calls on candidates to embrace the 24-point commitments that outline the framework of the campaign against deep poverty.

While working to make the unsustainable conditions of deep poverty visible and discuss poverty as a human rights violation, the Deep Poverty Network, providing basic needs support to people living in poverty with the #ChangeFromHome model as an emergency intervention, has launched a social media campaign calling on all parliamentary candidates to join this struggle. Immediately after publishing the fact sheet "Women and Child Poverty in Turkey: Some Urgent Problems", the Deep Poverty Network lists the steps that need to be taken to address these urgent problems in a 24-point list of commitments and addresses the parliamentary candidates from all parties participating in the elections with this campaign.

The call for Pledges campaign, inspired by similar examples from around the world, is not legally binding on those participating. However, it is hoped that the widespread use of this campaign and the increase in the number of parliamentary candidates who embrace the commitments will bring the struggle against deep poverty to the parliament's agenda that will be formed in the upcoming elections. The commitments that parliamentary candidates are asked to adopt and disseminate on social media were created in line with international agreements signed by the Republic of Turkey and based on the information gathered by the Network from the field. Önder Uçar, Research and Advocacy Coordinator of the Deep Poverty Network, said about the campaign: "Deep Poverty should be the primary area of struggle for all MPs, no matter who comes to power in the next election. If you say, 'I will put my signature under the commitments we have prepared for the fight against Deep Poverty,' we call on you, preparing for the election race to represent our common future, to pledge to #struggle!"
